"The Beautiful Collection" is not a self-proclaimed name. When Stefan exhibited for the first time at ESLÖVIA 2021 for qualifying, just three frames, the collection became somewhat of a sensation due to its beauty and quality. Among philatelists on the exhibition floor it was soon talked about using this nickname. The name stuck to the collection, also when it grew to four and later five frames, and deservedly so as there was no decline in quality, whatsoever.

As a lifelong stamp collector, starting as a young boy, Stefan made his first acquisitions of important classic Swedish items at a specialized auction in Switzerland almost 20 years ago. He soon after became a steady client at the Postiljonen auctions and continued to build his collection, mainly buying single stamps and covers in ultimate quality.

Always a gentleman allowing time for pleasant conversations, always with nice jokes at hand, Stefan soon became a good friend of ours. He asked for advice, when he decided to develop the collection into a high-level exhibit. It has been a great pleasure to be part of this "journey" which ended with a Gold Medal at NORDIA 2023. During the process, Stefan was not very happy, when we explained that he might have to slightly lower his quality requirements to be able to add certain rarities and important items to show a wider spectrum. Though we always added that he should only buy items that he liked himself and thereby would be happy with and enjoy. He often concluded that he would rather wait for a better copy of a certain rarity. In many cases this strategy was successful and he often found more beautiful items, later on.

For his approach and achievement, we can only bow and congratulate him! When he now has entrusted us to auction this unparalleled collection, it will be an utmost pleasure for us to perform this task. I can honestly say that although we have offered many exceptional collections during the years, none has been so homogenous in terms of quality. Every item is truly handpicked; Stefan did never buy one selection or a lot of several stamps for this collection. Always, each item one by one!

Stefan, your eyes for beauty and quality is impeccable! Thanks for years of very pleasant cooperation and great friendship.

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We always endeavour to simulate the actual auction situation for our mail bidders, you must however beforehand have determined the maximum you wish to pay for each lot and we will ensure that this maximum is not exceeded. Your bids must be in Euro and divisible by 10. The bidding always starts with the second highest mail bid plus the next increase (see conditions of sale sect. 2). The bidding then continues between the bidders in the audience and the highest mail bidder.

Avoid missing out on every item you wanted because of higher bids from others by bidding on many items but limit your total purchase to an amount of your choice (see bid form "my total purchase must not exceed:...excl. commission"). You can for example bid for a sum of $\leqslant 10\,000$ but limit your total purchase to $\leqslant 1\,000$ or any amount you wish.

You can also bid on two or several items and add "or" in between. We will then make sure that you get only one of these items.

Further, according to your instructions we can for example also raise your bid on one item if it turns out that you got another item less expensive than your highest bid.

Should there be two or more equal mail bids then the first bid received will buy the lot, so please submit your bids as early as possible.

To ensure you a safe handling of your bids, we need them *at least 24 hours* before the auction starts.





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Introduction

The story of a great collection

The first time I met Stefan Bielkhammar was at one of the auctions with bidding in Stockholm 2007/2008 where the collections of Ingvar Pettersson and Gustaf Johansson were up for sale. By chance we happened to sit next to each other in the auction room. As I recall the occasion we did, like typical Swedes not knowing each other before, just exchange a few polite words. Polite may, by the way, be Stefan's brand, he has always seemed like a true gentleman to me.

From that time, I was aware of Stefan's collecting interest in fine classic Swedish philatelic material but as Stefan for a long time never showed his collection publicly our paths seldom crossed, except as competitors for top quality material.

To me Stefan always has been a collector of only items he liked; rare, of high quality, and preferably beautiful in appearance. With a similar approach myself, it often turned out that I was the second highest bidder.

Exhibiting never seemed to be in Stefan's mind. This changed a couple of years ago when he showed an extract of his collection in a three frame exhibit at ESLÖVIA 2021. He was at that time unknown to most of the audience but soon after the opening of the exhibition a rumor was spread about a fantastic new Swedish exhibit in the regional class. Something everyone must have a look at. And then you understood where much of the material you had been overbid on had ended up...



Obviously encouraged by this success, Stefan came back already at the next national exhibition, Norrphil 2022 in Täby, with his exhibit expanded into four frames and a well-earned large vermeil medal.

After this, an obvious next target would be a Gold Medal at an international exhibition. It is easily understood that in a four frame format a large vermeil medal is about as good as it can possibly get and an expansion to five frames a necessity if this should be achieved.

It is not easy to add another frame in a short time, but Stefan had more top material in his drawers and with the acquisition of some more material and a somewhat improved write-up Stefan gave it a try at NORDIA 2023 in Reykjavik, Iceland. It is difficult to be awarded a Gold Medal for a five frame exhibit, but with the high standards Stefan always has strived for it was no surprise to me that he, if anyone, could achieve this.

And then... In the autumn of 2023, during a lunch I learned that Stefan was about to sell his collection. To me this came totally out of the blue. My belief was that eventually we would enjoy Stefan's collection in a full eight frame format and then most likely with a Large Gold medal award. In my mind the potential certainly was there and in many ways I regret that he has decided not to continue exhibiting.

Instead, we now have the opportunity to go for the second best and admire the material in upcoming auction catalogues and of course to incorporate pieces from Stefan's collection into our own. Not a bad thing, I can assure everyone!

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




There are so many things to see and do in Copenhagen so please bring your family and extend your stay to more than the 4 exhibition days.



The HAFNIA 24 official block consist of four stamps of 25 DKK and is only valid for inland letters. The stamps show image cuts taken from stamps issued in the last 100 years. In the middle you see the main entrance to Øksnehallen, the exhibition venue for HAFNIA 24. You can buy your copy from the Danish Philatelic Federation Web-shop newstamps.dk from 2 January 2024.
